Tutor has a few that can be shared You may like to bring a small selection of beads that can be used in conjunction with the Inner-tubes Jewellery findings (head-pins, links, clasps, ear-wires etc) or tutor can supply a set for \$5.00 A quick-unpick (as used for unpicking stitching) Pen, pencil, writing paper Scissors, ruler
