We are currently seeking a suitably qualified, energetic and reliable person to lead our Mini Master Cooks classes during Terms 2 and 3, 2019.

The program is for primary school aged children and runs on a Tuesday afternoon, from 4.30pm – 6pm. The cooking teacher is responsible for setting the program, which runs for 7 – 8 weeks. In the past, this has included making one main and one dessert per 1.5hr session. Term 2 classes commence on Tuesday 30th April, 2019.

The class runs with a minimum of 6 students and a maximum of 9 students. Experience delivering similar cooking programs is desirable and experience teaching children is essential.
