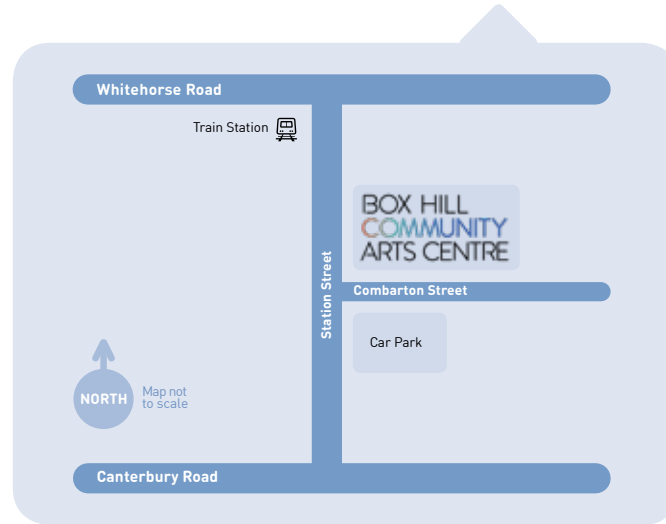
Opening Hours
